THREE TYPES OF MUTUALLY BENEFICIAL RELATIONSHIPS

1. WE REFER TO YOU.

We are delighted to refer young parents and families to other organizations that serve young parents. For example:

<u>Delgracia Corp.</u> is a vital partner in supporting young moms, children, and families referred by TAHP. Delgracia provides onsite and in-home visits and attends court and school meetings with young parents as needed. TAHP referred participants are assigned a social worker and intern throughout their care term.

2. TWO-WAY REFERRALS.

Our community-serving relationships often evolve to support two-way referrals. For example:

- With the <u>Brownsville Community Justice Center</u>, TAHP interviews and enrolls eligible moms while the Center provides direct contact information to our case manager for assistance. The Center provides onsite space for TAHP to facilitate parenting classes for their clients, and when appropriate, the Center refers expectant and parenting moms to TAHP for additional support services.
- » <u>Urban Upbound</u> provides youth and adults tools and resources needed to achieve economic prosperity. TAHP sends our participants to Urban Upbound for training and placement services for entry-level jobs. In return, Urban Upbound refers expectant and current moms to benefit from our in-depth supportive programming.

Other partners contract with TAHP for peer-led parent training, leadership training, or parent and youth recruitment. For example:

As a peer-led organization, TAHP is uniquely capable of building trusting community relationships.
